## SOCIOLOGICAL APPROACH ACTION OF PATRIOTISM FROM THE MOVIE THE PATRIOT

As a result, movies can be enjoyed anytime, anywhere (Asia & Samanik, 2018), (Novanti & Suprayogi, 2021). However, filmmakers must pay close attention to the message and meaning conveyed by each scene (Qodriani & Kardiansyah, 2018), (Kuswoyo & Audina, 2020). Due to the fact that audiences can be affected and influence what they watch for, both cognitively and emotionally (Kuswoyo & Indonesia, 2021), (Kardiansyah, 2021). Benjamin Martin, who starred in the Patriot film and was played by Mel Gibson, was a single father of seven children (Budiman et al., 2021), (Oktavia & Suprayogi, 2021), (Afrianto & Restika, 2018). The roles of Gabriel Martin and Colonel Tavington are played by Heath Ledger and Jason Isaacs, respectively (Amelia, 2021), (Puspita, 2021). Benjamin Martin, a war veteran with strong family values, was reluctant to go to war because he had experienced its effects and regretted it. However, his first son, Gabriel, was just as stubborn as Benjamin Martin (Kuswanto et al., 2020), (Gulö, 2018). He insisted that he join the military without his father's permission (Fakhrurozi & Adrian, 2021). However, he instructed Martin not to place his son on the front line and made him the messenger as a result of his father's lieutenant friend's presence there (Pranoto & Suprayogi, 2020b).

Briefly, Martin went into battle after his second son was shot to death by Colonel Tavington while trying to save Gabriel (Afrianto & Gulö, 2019). Martin went down to the royal streets after he formed a militia and went to see his friend who was a Colonel (Puspita & Amelia, 2020), (Hutauruk & Puspita, 2020). Martin was able to do his guerrilla tactics by intercepting packages sent by the British empire from the ship into their landscape (Arpiansah et al., 2021), (Lestari & Wahyudin, 2020). He had succeeded several times, to the point where he was framed by the English Colonel Tavington, who cost him half his army and held them off for hanging (Pradana & Suprayogi, 2021), (Sartika & Pranoto, 2021). Martin's tactical games, trying to negotiate with British General Cornwellis to exchange prisoners. The English agreed, and then Martin took them away, but for this, General Cornwellis was furious that he was duped (Mandasari & Aminatun, 2020) and mocked because the officer in custody was only a straw (F. M. Sari & Oktaviani, 2021).

The General asked the Colonel in any way that he might get Martin, but with the assurance that whatever way the Colonel does is entirely the responsibility of the General (Mandasari, n.d.) and with that his reputation is safe and he can still go home to England (Afrianto et al., 2021), (Aldino, Hendra, et al., 2021). The General approved of his brutal tactics and succeeded in killing and burning the homes of militiamen belonging to Martin's army (Aguss et al., 2021), (Purwaningsih & Gulö, 2021). Because of this, Martin allowed his troops to return home and meet their families with the message: "You can go home for a week (Kardiansyah & Salam, 2020). After that, you may return, and those who do not return will not be called cowards." It was not a sign of surrender but the militias again gathered and discussed (Aminatun & Oktaviani, 2019), (Oktaviani & Mandasari, 2020). Then they joined the core forces to fight together, led by Martin. Their victory pushed the English back to the port (S. N. Sari & Aminatun, 2021), (Kuswoyo et al., 2020). The history of the people Benjamin Martin, Gabriel, and the militias who reflected the strong virtues of Patriotism.

There are many ways to recapture history and to film one of them (K. Sari & Pranoto, 2021). Through the film, we too can take life lessons or even recall history in a more exciting way (Ivana & Suprayogi, 2020), (Samanik, 2018). Coles and Armstrong say that they study history to spare time (Teknologi et al., 2021). On the other hand, Hunt prefers to call "serious leisure pursuit" to fill his spare time learning useful stuff (Ahmad et al., 2021), (Fadilah & Kuswoyo, 2021). As a means of education, learning history through the media

like film is a newly developed medium (Mertania & Amelia, 2020). In the past, we learned or knew the history that we know through ancient tales told by word of mouth (Oktaviani, 2021), (Mandasari, 2020). It then transformed into reading it from a book as the conventional way. But now the media is growing (Wahyudin & Sari, 2018), (Asmiati et al., 2019), (Afrianto & Ma'rifah, 2020). There are many digital media or other digital platforms to support history study (Suprayogi & Pranoto, 2020). Quoted from (Isnaini & Aminatun, 2021), (Endang Woro Kasih, 2018) that learning history can also be a game. Because history is put into the education materials, even the curriculum (Journal et al., 2021), (Yulianti & Sulistiyawati, 2020).

The film industry hosts many types of genres, types, themes, ect (Fithratullah, 2019), (Qodriani, 2021). This time, the writer would like to conduct one of the films on a war theme (Aminatun, 2021), (Choirunnisa & Mandasari, 2021). There are many cool movies with the most topic of war to talk about like Troy, Braveheart, 300, and The Patriot (Neneng et al., 2021), (Pranoto & Afrilita, 2019). From what I've already mentioned, it's not uncommon to find prominent figures embedded in it, and this time the writer wishes to discuss the Patriot (Ngestirosa et al., 2020), (Nababan & Nurmaily, 2021). The Patriot is a film depicting the war history between America and the British (Yulianti & Sulistyawati, 2021), (Fithratullah, 2021). The film was released in 2000 (Qodriani & Wijana, 2020) and directed by Roland Emmerich and starring Mel Gibson, Heath Ledger, and Jason Isaacs. Mel Gibson (Setri & Setiawan, 2020), who had the view of war as Benjamin Martin, was just a lost cause and for the benefit of a few, but that changed (Aldino, Saputra, et al., 2021), (Qodriani & Wijana, 2021). Martin joined the U.S. army to avenge his son's death. There was the attitude as well as the words of Martin that reflected Patriotism (Candra & Qodriani, 2019), (Puspita, 2019). For that attitude, the text is intended to discuss the matter by using a sociological approach.

Thus, the writer wanted to delineate the relevant side of sociology shown by Martin in the movie The Patriot. The film shows that they fight to achieve independence. They sacrificed warriors who died on the battlefield, families who were burned alive, people who went to war, too. They are pursuing freedom, because it is the key to a nation's life. The struggle and sacrifice they make to achieve a freedom is an object of study that can represent the sociology of human life.

#### LITERATURE REVIEW


